

PuTTY is a free implementation of Telnet and SSH for MS Windows along with an xterm terminal emulator. It is written and maintained primarily by [Simon Tatham](#).

The PuTTY suite of software includes:

- PuTTY (the Telnet and SSH client itself)
- PSCP (an SCP client, i.e. command-line secure file copy)
- PSFTP (an SFTP client, i.e. general file transfer sessions much like FTP)

1) Open up PuTTY and enter "[goldhill.cgd.ucar.edu](#)" in the Host Name field and check the SSH button underneath it.
